Cascade Clamps - Founded in Portland, Oregon in the year 1943, the Cascade Manufacturing Company began as a small machine shop hiring just 4 individuals. Overall sales for that particular year totaled 60 thousand dollars. The very first recorded sales revenues involved the assembly and machining of stainless-steel valves, pipe fittings and various components. Through 5 years of operation, the company had expanded to 40 workers and their annual sales volume had increased to \$330,000. Nowadays, Cascade is one of the top global producers in the material handling business.

Design and production of the company's original hydraulic cylinder allowed this young company to aggressively engage in new business possibilities. Throughout the final 60 years, the business of material handling has developed into a very advanced field with Cascade proudly playing a part in its development. Cascade currently continues to develop as the best supplier of forklift attachments and numerous related products. The company feels certain in their ability so as to continue to lead the way in the business by understanding buyer's needs in the future and remaining competitive in the world market.

During the 1950's, Cascade started to manufacture, design, and advertise its hydraulic accessories. A new facility was made in 1956, so as to house all the plant offices and operations in Portland, Oregon, which continues to be the company's current headquarters. Subsequent to 15 years of business, total employees reached 180 staff and sales had reached practically 2.3 million dollars.

1959 in Springfield, Ohio the next production plant was built. 1960 marked Cascade's initial move into the international world of the material handling industry as the company recognized interest in England, Australia, and the Netherlands.

In the year 1964, the company altered its name to the Cascade Corporation. After that in 1965, the company went public with an initial offering of 200,000 shares of common stock. Since then the business has expanded its manufacturing facilities within the continental US to the places Warner Robins Georgia to go along with its already present plants in Springfield, Ohio and Portland, Oregon. Cascade merchandise are made globally because of numerous subsidiary operations. In the year 1944, a brand new plant was accomplished in Almere, the Netherlands which is Cascade's European command center. This plant is made to be the essential customer support centre.

Cascade further expanded their product base in the year 1996 and 1997 subsequent to acquiring five corporations, which included the Kenhar Corporation, the international best in forks.
